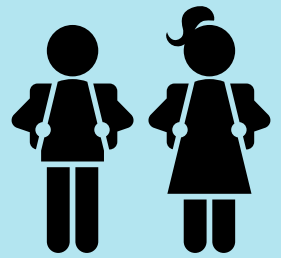


HPV and Cancer Prevention



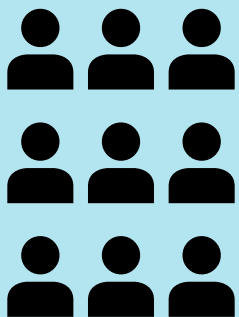
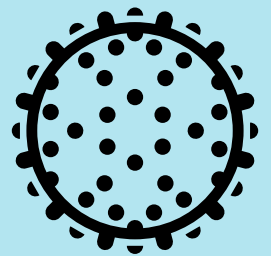
HPV vaccination is the best way to safely prevent many types of cancer, including **cervical cancer**.

HPV vaccination is recommended at **ages 11 or 12** for girls *and* boys.



HPV is responsible for **27,000** new cancer diagnoses each year.

Human papillomavirus (HPV) is the **most common** viral infection of the reproductive system in the U.S.



More than **14 million people**, including teenagers, become infected with HPV each year.
